CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS

- **ARTICLE 1.** This decree sets the minimum and maximum rates for the allocation of the fee for rent-to-own property.
- **ARTICLE 2.-** The fee for home purchase leases shall be the consideration for the buyer's right of option. It shall comprise a portion corresponding to the purchaser's right to use the home and a portion corresponding to the advance payment of the price of the home.
- **ARTICLE 3.-** (1) The rent-to-own charge shall represent the monthly instalment payable by the first-time buyer for the progressive payment of his or her obligations until the sale price of the home has been paid.
- (2) It shall be determined by means of an depreciation table of the sale price of the property on the basis of the following elements:
 - the sale price of the property;
 - the booking deposit;
 - the buyer's income;
 - the interest rate agreed between the parties;
 - the term of the contract, which takes account of the buyer's age.

CHAPTER II DETERMINATION OF MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM RATES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FEES

- **ARTICLE 4**.- (1) The minimum and maximum rental rates for home ownership shall correspond to the portion of the buyer's income that can be transferred or seized. They are set as follows:
 - from 28 to 33% for social housing;
 - from 10 to 33% for other cases.
- (2) Once the fee has been calculated, its two parts shall be made up as follows:
 - the part corresponding to the right to use the property (non-refundable) is equal to the rent for each type of property;
 - the part corresponding to the prepayment of the price of the accommodation (refundable) is the difference between the amount of the fee and the rent for the property.
- (3) Payments on account of the purchase price may be made by the first-time buyer at the time the homebuyer's lease is concluded, with a view to adjusting the amount of the rental charge so that it complies with the rates indicated in paragraph 1.
