- 6- A certificate of nationality;
- 7- 03 passport size photos;
- 8- 20.000 FCFA, registration fees.

The application documents mentioned above must be submitted at the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development, **Department of Architecture and Housing Norms, door 05B05 on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of Block B of the Ministerial Building N°1, latest on Friday, 18 April, 2025 at 3:30 p.m. prompt.**
